COMMAND HISTORY USS BLACK HAWK (MHC 58)

BLACK HAWK (MHC 58) is the eighth ship in the U. S. Navy's OSPREY Class Coastal Minehunter Program and the third U. S. Navy ship to bear the name. BLACK HAWK's keel was laid on September 3, 1992, and her christening and launching took place on August 27, 1994. MHC 51 Class ships are the world's largest Glass Reinforced Plastic (GRP) ships and the first U. S. Navy ships designed solely for mine hunting, the technique of locating mines with sonar and neutralizing them with a remotely controlled underwater vehicle. The ship's mission is to clear harbor, coastal and ocean waters of acoustic, magnetic and pressure/contact type mines, utilizing reconnaissance, classification and neutralization tactics. The MHC 51 Class design integrates modern mine countermeasures technology into a uniquely designed platform. The ship is protected during mine hunting operations with an exceptionally low magnetic and acoustic signature.

BLACK HAWK completed Tailored Ship Training Availability Phase III (TSTA III) underway in CCOA..

20-31 MAY

BLACK HAWK conducted maintenance upkeep period.

01-02 JUNE

BLACK HAWK finished the Basic Phase of the Inter-deployment Training Cycle (IDTC) by completing the Final Evaluation Problem (FEP) underway in CCOA.

BLACK HAWK gets underway for a two month East-coast summer cruise.

BLACK HAWK underway in Panama City Florida Operation Area (PCOA) for mine warfare training. During the training BLACK HAWK completed over fifteen mine neutralization vehicle missions including prosecution of a deep water moored training mine.

BLACK HAWK underway enroute Key West, Florida.

19-21 JUNE

BLACK HAWK inport Key West, Florida.

22-23 JUNE

BLACK HAWK underway enroute Naval Station Mayport, Florida.

24-26 JUNE

BLACK HAWK inport Naval Station Mayport, Florida.

27 JUNE - 01 JULY

BLACK HAWK underway enroute New Haven, Connecticut.

01-05 JULY

BLACK HAWK conducted port visit in New Haven, Connecticut. During port visit, BLACK HAWK held an Independence Day reception for over

five hundred people including the mayor of the city. Additionally, BLACK HAWK conducted general public ship tours for over one thousand five hundred people.

06-12 JULY

BLACK HAWK conducted port visit at Naval Station Newport, Rhode Island. During port visit, BLACK HAWK served as Surface Warfare Officers School training ship, hosting tours for the division officer's course and engineering department head course.

13 JULY

BLACK HAWK underway enroute Naval Station Little Creek, Virginia.

14-16 JULY

BLACK HAWK inport Naval Station Little Creek, Virginia.

17-19 JULY

BLACK HAWK underway enroute Port Everglades, Florida.
