1. This Command History is for the period of 1 January 2001 to 31 December 2001 and is submitted in accordance with reference (a).

2. COMMAND COMPOSITION AND ORGANIZATION.

a. During 2001, USS BOISE completed a Tactical Weapons Proficiency, an Operational Reactor Safeguards Examination, and several VIP cruises in Port Everglades, FL and Norfolk, VA. BOISE exercised numerous submarine roles during COMPTUEX and local operations, including anti-submarine warfare, anti-surface warfare, and coordinated operations.

b. BOISE is administratively responsible to Commander, Submarine Squadron EIGHT, Norfolk, Virginia; Commander, Submarine Group TWO, Groton, Connecticut; and Commander Submarine Force, U.S. Atlantic Fleet.

c. CDR David L. Leach was the Commanding Officer of BOISE until March 22 when he was relieved by CDR James M. Kuzma. The Executive Officer was LCDR Chuck Hamilton until February 20 when he was relieved by LCDR Robert Moore. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] LCDR John Carter served as interim Executive Officer from November 10 until December 13 when he was relieved by LCDR Andrew Wannamaker.
