2. Commander's Assessment:

CARNEY began 2003 by commencing her Unit Level Training Phase. While inport, her Sailors ran drills in preparation for qualifications, including General Quarters, Air and Surface Warfare scenarios, Strike scenarios, Engineering evolutions, and many Force Protection exercises, which culminated in a Commander's Assessment of Readiness and Training Part II, Engineering Underway Demonstration, and Final Evaluation Problem in the late Fall.

CARNEY was underway for short training periods within the Jacksonville Operating Area throughout the winter months. January marked CARNEY's Supply and Materials Inspection.

CARNEY's first major underway was in March when she transited to the Gulf of Mexico for a public relations port visit in Pensacola, FL. CARNEY was also underway in March for a battlegroup sail and a Commander's Assessment of Readiness Training Part II. CARNEY participated in an additional battlegroup sail in April off the coast of Cape Canaveral.

From mid May through mid July, CARNEY was inport for an extended Chief of Naval Operations' Selected Restricted Availability maintenance period. With a brief hiatus in July for training to include a Strike Exercise, CARNEY continued her scheduled repairs for the months of August and September.

Throughout the time inport, CARNEY continued her Unit Level Training in all mission areas. In the beginning of September, CARNEY successfully certified her Aviation program. By the beginning of October, CARNEY got underway for a successful Engineering Light-Off Assessment and Navigation Certification.

In addition to training, CARNEY took some time on September 11 to honor 9 Firefighters from Engine Company 65 who died in the tragic events a year earlier in New York City. CARNEY dedicated a memorial to Fireman McCann who answered the call to duty and sacrificed his life to save others.

In mid-October, CARNEY transited to Newport, Rhode Island for a well deserved port visit. She was hosted by the Surface Warfare Officer School. After a successful visit, CARNEY proceeded to Yorktown, VA for ammunition onload.

The months of November and December were full of training and victorious off ship assessments. CARNEY passed her Cruise Missile and Tomahawk Qualifications with flying colors. For Engineering, CARNEY successfully completed her Underway Demonstration. Finally, CARNEY completed her Unit Level Training Phase in mid December by passing her Final Evaluation Problem.

CARNEY closed out another successful year with the Holiday Season. Following a Christmas party, the first of two holiday leave periods commenced and Carney began its Holiday Leave and Upkeep Period.
