#### 2. Commander's Assessment:

The year 2004 was an eventful year onboard CARNEY. The first half of the year, CARNEY was thoroughly involved in battle group exercises and public relations port visits. She had a Change of Command as well. All of her training finally paid off at the end of the year when CARNEY was assigned to Sixth Fleet in the Mediterranean Sea for a Surface Strike Group deployment.

At the end of January, CARNEY participated in a Fleet Week Celebration in Fort Lauderdale. CARNEY promoted the Navy to the city. Additionally in January, CARNEY helped her fellow battle group by playing the role as Opposing Forces for the JFK Battle group.

In the end of February, CARNEY was underway for the first phase of her Composite Training Unit Exercise. After a port visit in Tampa, FL, CARNEY completed the COMPTUEX training and return to Mayport for the Commanding Officer's Change of Command Ceremony. On 22<sup>nd</sup> of March, CDR Joseph Chiaravallotti took command of the USS CARNEY.

CARNEY's first major underway under her new Commanding Officer was for a Public Relations port visit in New York City, New York. CARNEY joined a plethora of ships for New York's Fleet Week Celebration in May.

In June, CARNEY participated in Joint Task Force Exercises in the Cherry Point Operating Area. CARNEY was able to flex her capabilities while working with Foreign Naval Vessels. CARNEY conducted special evolutions in all mission areas, from Naval Surface Fire Support to Engineering Evolutions.

In July, CARNEY participated in some Submarine exercises in the JAXOPAREA. She conducted a Sink Exercise as well as a Submarine Training and Evaluation Exercise. Upon completion, CARNEY transited to Pensacola, FL for a port visit. Next CARNEY was a key player in the AMALGOM VIRGO Exercise in the Gulf of Mexico.

CARNEY completed a maintenance availability in August, in preparations for her 2004 deployment. Upon completion, she conducted a Standing Naval Forces Atlantic (SNFL) Combined Exercise off the Cherry point operating area.

Most of October and November were Pre-Overseas Movement leave and upkeep. CARNEY completed an ammunitions onload in preparations for her deployment during this time as well.

On 29 November 2004, CARNEY commenced her transatlantic voyage to the Mediterranean Sea. She first stopped in Rota, Spain on the 4<sup>th</sup> of December for fuel and supplies. Then she continued through the Straight of Gibraltar, stopping in Augusta Bay, Sicily for more stores. CARNEY's first official port visit was Naples, Italy on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of December.

CARNEY remained in Italy through Christmas and began transiting to Cartegna Spain for New Years on the 27<sup>th</sup> of December. CARNEY brought in the New Year in Spain, with five months remaining on her deployment.
