1. USS CHICAGO (SSN 721) is a Los Angeles Class Fast Attack Submarine assigned to Submarine Squadron EIGHT in the U.S. Atlantic Fleet Submarine Force. CHICAGO is homeported in Norfolk, Va. and is commanded by Commander Stanley R. Szemborski.

2. Chronology:

05 January 1987 - USS CHICAGO (SSN 721) entered Post Shakedown Availability.

20 March 1987 - Commander Stanley R. Szemborski relieved Captain Robert B. Avery as Commanding Officer.

01 December 1987- Post Overhaul Reactor Safeguards Examination completed with an evaluation of Above Average.

3. During 1987 USS CHICAGO was in Post Shakedown Availability (PSA) at Newport News Shipbuilding at Newport News, Va. Significant weapons and engineering system modifications have been made during this availability. These changes significantly improve CHICAGO's war fighting capabilities. Upon completion of PSA, CHICAGO will be one of the most capable attack submarines in the United States Submarine Fleet.
