NARRATIVE

USS CHICAGO began the year with a week of underway refresher training. On 4 January, CHICAGO conducted a Distinguished Visitor Cruise for the 721 Club, the ship's namesake city sponsor club from Chicago. The ship then conducted her final pre-deployment upkeep at Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard. Following upkeep, CHICAGO conducted deployment weapons loadout at West Loch then went to sea for final pre-deployment operational training and certification.

Following a one-week pierside loadout period, USS CHICAGO departed from Pearl Harbor on 6 March for her first full deployment in five years. While deployed, USS CHICAGO conducted the following significant events:

- Two Special Operations
- First SSN to participate in CARAT Malaysia. Embarked two Malaysian naval officers.
- SHIN KAME 01-01, first SSN to conduct sub vs. sub exercise with HARUSHIO-class JMSDF submarine
 - Upkeeps in Guam and Yokosuka Japan
 - Host ship for COMSUBGRU SEVEN Change of Command
 - Port visits to Saipan CNMI, Singapore, and Perth Australia.
 - VIP embark for Governor of CNMI
 - Brief port stops in Okinawa and Sasebo Japan

CHICAGO returned from deployment on 23 August and commenced a 30-day stand down. The stand down was terminated abruptly on 11 September following the terrorist attacks on the United States and CHICAGO went to maximum force protection posture.

In late September, CHICAGO offloaded her deployment weapons loadout and proceeded to sea for an exercise with JDS WAKASHIO, followed by torpedo proficiency firings at PMRF. CHICAGO then began a two-month drydocking availability at Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard. The availability included major modernization of sonar and navigation systems and a battery changeout.

Following the availability, CHICAGO went to sea for a week of sea trials and refresher training. Returning to port on 21 December, CHICAGO remained pierside for the holiday period through the end of the year.
