USS DALLAS (SSN 700) Command History for 1984

DALLAS began 1984 with a two month Selected Restricted Availability (SRA) in Groton, CT, completing the SRA one day ahead of schedule. After several weeks at sea conducting refresher training DALLAS began a pre-overseas movement workup and certification period, culminated by a Tactical Readiness Evaluation in May. DALLAS departed on 18 May for a seven month Indian Ocean deployment.

While in the Indian Ocean DALLAS conducted operations and exercises with two carrier battle groups and a maritime patrol aircraft squadron. Ports visited included Diego Garcia, BIOT, and Perth and Albany in Western Australia.

DALLAS circumnavigated the globe during the deployment by transiting around the southern tip of Africa, across the Indian and Pacific Oceans, and through the Panama Canal. The Nuclear Propulsion Examining Board embarked at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, and a successful Operational Reactor Safeguards Examination was conducted during part of the return transit to Groton.
