USS DALLAS (SSN 700) Command History for 1985

DALLAS began 1985 with a standdown period and a much needed upkeep following the completion of the 1984 Indian Ocean deployment. On 4 February 1985, CDR F. W. LACROIX, relieved CDR W. A. RAWSON Jr. as Commanding Officer. The ship participated in two fleet exercises, LANTSUBASWEX 3-85 and READEX 1-85. These exercises were followed by a Tactical Readiness Examination in May and MK 48 torpedo open ocean firings in June.

DALLAS conducted a drydocking in June to repair the secondary propulsion motor then participated in a third fleet exercise, READEX 2-85, throughout July. In September, DALLAS completed a CNO project at Exuma Sound, conducted MK 48 torpedo proficiency firings and had a port visit in Port Everglades, Florida.

The ship's battery was replaced in October followed by an Operational Reactor Safeguards Examination. The year was culminated with the conduct of Preoverseas Movement training prior to the anticipated Mediterranean Sea deployment in January 1986.
