1. USS DALLAS (SSN 700) is an SSN 688 Los Angeles class nuclear powered, fast attack submarine, homeported at New London Submarine Base, Groton, Connecticut. USS DALLAS is under the operational command of Commander, Submarine Squadron TWO. DALLAS' primary mission is anti-submarine warfare. The Commanding Officer is Commander Richard P. Terpstra.

2. During 1990, DALLAS completed the following significant events:

3. In January through July the USS DALLAS completed numerous inspections and examinations of weapons, sonar, & reactor systems in preparations for a Mediterranean deployment, including a comprehensive evaluation of the Towed

4. On 7 August, DALLAS deployed on a six month Mediterranean mission and among other operations, participated in the major NATO exercise "Display Determination." The Commander, Sixth Fleet awarded DALLAS the Anti-Submarine Warfare Excellence Award, for her accomplishments in the Mediterranean.
