1. USS DALLAS (SSN 700) is an SSN 688 Los Angeles class nuclear powered, fast attack submarine, homeported at New London Submarine Base, Groton, Connecticut. USS DALLAS is under the operational command of Commander, Submarine Squadron TWO. DALLAS' primary mission is anti-submarine warfare. The Commanding Officer is Commander Richard P. Terpstra.

2. During 1991, DALLAS completed the following significant events:

3. Throughout the year USS DALLAS completed numerous inspections and examinations of weapons, sonar, reactor and command administrative areas.

4. On 1 October 1991 DALLAS received several awards, most notably the Battle Efficiency Award for Submarine Squadron TWO. Other awards included Communications "C", ASW "A" and the Golden Anchor Award for retention excellence.
