1. USS DALLAS (SSN 700) is an SSN 688 Los Angeles class nuclear powered, fast attack submarine, homeported at New London Submarine Base, Groton, Connecticut. USS DALLAS is under the operational command of Commander, Submarine Squadron TWO. DALLAS' primary mission is anti-submarine warfare. The Commanding Officer is Commander John J. Schwanz.


2. During 1992, DALLAS completed the following significant events:

18 December 1992	Change of Command

3. Throughout the year USS DALLAS completed numerous inspections and examinations of weapons, sonar, reactor and command administrative areas.

4. On 18 December 1992 DALLAS conducted a Change of Command Ceremony in which Commander John Joseph Schwanz relieved Commander Richard Paul Terpstra. Commander Schwanz's biography is included with this command history along with the change of command pamphlet.

5. DALLAS received the following awards for calendar year 1992:  
- Battle Efficiency "E" (second consecutive award).
