1. USS DALLAS (SSN-700) is a SSN 688 Los Angeles class nuclear powered fast attack submarine, home ported at New London Submarine Base, Groton, Connecticut. USS DALLAS is under the operational command of Commander, Submarine Squadron TWO. DALLAS' primary mission is anti-submarine warfare. The Commanding Officer is Commander John J. Schwanz.


2. During 1993, DALLAS completed the following significant events:

October- December 1993	Atlantic Deployment

3. USS DALLAS completed two major command inspections, hosted various VIPs, a news team from Dallas, Texas, and was the subject of a special newspaper article in the Dallas, Texas, "Dallas Morning News." DALLAS' major accomplishment for the year was the completion of an Atlantic deployment.

4. DALLAS received the following awards for calendar year 1993:

- Battle Efficiency "E" (third consecutive award).
- COMSUBLANT nomination for the Battenberg Cup. Cited by CINCLANTFLT as "The Best All Around" submarine in the fleet.
