1. USS DALLAS (SSN-700) is a SSN 688 Los Angeles class nuclear powered fast attack submarine, home ported at New London Submarine Base, Groton, Connecticut. USS DALLAS is under the operational command of Commander, Submarine Squadron TWO. DALLAS' primary mission is anti-submarine warfare. The Commanding Officer is Commander John J. Schwanz.


2. During 1994, DALLAS completed the following significant events:

October - December 1994	Selected Restricted Availability (SRA)

3. USS DALLAS completed two major command inspections and hosted various VIPs. DALLAS' major accomplishment for the year was the completion of an Atlantic deployment.
