Subj: SUBMISSION OF USS DALLAS COMMAND HISTORY FOR 1995

1. USS DALLAS (SSN 700) is a SSN 688 Los Angeles class nuclear powered fast attack submarine, currently homeported at Portsmouth Naval Shipyard, Portsmouth, New Hampshire. Under the operational command of Submarine Group TWO, USS DALLAS' primary mission is the completion of an engineering refueling overhaul. The Commanding Officer is Commander John C. Kamp.

2. During 1995, DALLAS completed the following significant events:

Dates	Event
January 1995	Provided services for tactical readiness exams. Preoverhaul testing program.
February - March 1995	Preoverseas movement preparations
April - July 1995	Deployment
August 1995	Change of command. Upkeep, Groton CT. Pre-change of homeport preparations
September 1995	Change of homeport to Portsmouth, NH Change of operational command from Submarine Squadron TWO to Submarine Group Two. Commencement of overhaul.
October - December 1995	Engineering Refueling Overhaul (ERO)

3. USS DALLAS completed a major command inspection consisting of a complete test of the ships material condition. On August 1 1995, Commander John C. Kamp relieved Commander John J. Schwanz as Commanding Officer of USS DALLAS. DALLAS' major accomplishments in 1995 include a deployment and a change of homeport from New London Submarine Base, Groton, Connecticut to Portsmouth Naval Shipyard, Portsmouth, New Hampshire.
