
1. Per reference (a) the following is submitted: USS DALLAS (SSN 700) is an SSN 688 Los Angeles class nuclear attack submarine. DALLAS is currently home ported at Portsmouth Naval Shipyard, Portsmouth, New Hampshire. Under the operational command of Submarine Group TWO, DALLAS' primary mission is the completion of an engineering refueling overhaul. The commanding officer is Commander John C. Kamp.

2. During 1997, DALLAS completed the following significant events:

June 1997	Reactor Safeguards Exam (RSE)
July - August 1997	Combat Systems Assessment Review (CSAR)
August - November 1997	Integrated Propulsion Plant Testing (IPPTP)
January - December 1997	Engineering Refueling Overhaul (ERO)

3. USS DALLAS is in the process of completing the final stages of a two year Engineering Refueling Overhaul.

4. Throughout the year USS DALLAS has completed numerous inspections and examinations of engineering, navigation, and weapons departments, readying the ship to return to sea.
