- 1. USS DOLPHIN (AGSS 555) is a deep diving research and development diesel-electric submarine. The ship is under the operational control of Commander Submarine Development Group ONE, home ported in San Diego, CA. Commander Joseph P. Peterson, USN, is currently serving as the Commanding Officer.
- 2. The following chronology of events reflect the ship's operations for calender year 1995.
- a. 10-13 January 1995: Underway for independent steaming exercises (ISE).
  - b. 14-16 February 1995: Underway for ISE.
- c. 27 February 2 March 1995: Underway for periscope signature measurements and ISE.
- d. 6-10 March 1995: Underway for Exercise KERNAL BLITZ and to perform radiated noise survey with RV Flip. Commander Submarine Force Pacific Fleet (RADM Jon M. Barr) toured ship.
- e. 30-31 March 1995: Moored at Naval Submarine Base, San Diego, CA for Commander Submarine Group FIVE and Commander Submarine Squadron THREE deactivation ceremony.
  - f. 11-12 May 1995: Underway for ISE.
- g. 22-26 May 1995: Underway for Deep Ocean Transponder deactivation and ISE.
- h. 9-19 June 1995: Underway for Port to Port towing demonstration and ISE.

Subj: USS DOLPHIN (AGSS 555) COMMAND HISTORY FOR CALENDER YEAR 1995

- i. 23-29 June 1995: Underway for Emergency Towing Exercise and for the following inspections: Operations Readiness Examination, Engineering Readiness Examination, Communications Readiness Evaluation and Navigation Evaluation.
- j. 10 July 21 August 1995: Deployed to the Pacific Northwest to support the MK-50 Torpedo Test Program. Port visits to Eureka, Ca., Bangor, Wa., Naniamo, and Victoria, British Columbia, Canada.
- k. 18-22 September 1995: Underway for WESMAR Sonar operational testing minefield surveys in support of AN/BQS-15 EC 17 testing.
- 1. 13-17 November 1995: Underway for Mobile Inland Undersea Warfare (MIUW) support, Beartrap Crew Certification, and High Resolution Electronic Imaging Undersea System (HELIUS) certification and testing.
- m. 27 November 1 December 1995: Underway for HELIUS testing and certification.
- n. 8-15 December 1995: Underway for MK-50 Torpedo openocean testing.
- 3. USS DOLPHIN (AGSS 555) performed various complex research and development projects throughout the year. All operations where evaluated as successful. One major ship's configuration change involved the installation of the High Resolution Electronic Imaging Undersea System. USS DOLPHIN (AGSS 555) was awarded the Commander Submarine Force Pacific Fleet Communications Green "C" and the Engineering Red "E" for Special Category for 1995.




