COMMAND COMPOSITION AND ORGANIZATION

USS ELROD (FFG 55) is an OLIVER HAZARD PERRY-Class guided missile frigate. Originally designated for Anti-Submarine Warfare (ASW) and Anti-Air Warfare (AAW) duties. ELROD has been highly successful in conducting Maritime Interception, Drug Interdiction Operations, and Search and Rescue (SAR) missions.

ELROD is armed with Mk 46 anti-submarine torpedoes, Harpoon surface-tosurface cruise missiles, SM1 (MR) surface to air missiles, a Mk 75 automatic, rapid fire 76mm cannon, and 25mm chain gun. Weapons, sensors, and control systems include: Mk 32 Surface Vessel Torpedo Tubes (SVTT), Mk 13 Guided Missile Launching System (GMLS), Mk 75 76mm Oto Melara Lightweight Gun, Mk 15 Mod 11 Block IB Close In Weapons System (CIWS), AN/SYS-2 Integrated Air Detection System (IADS), Mk 92 Mod 6 Coherent Receiver Transmitter (CORT) Fire Control System, AN/SLQ-32 (V) 5 Electronic Warfare Suite, which includes the AN/SQR-19 Tactical Towed Array Sonar System (TACTAS), the AN/SQQ-28 Sonobouy Processor, and the SH-60 LAMPS Mk III Helicopter.

ELROD's complement includes 18 officers and 184 crewmembers. ELROD is homeported at Norfolk Naval Station, Norfolk, Virginia, and is under the command of Commander Charles J. Neary. ELROD's immediate senior in command is Commander, Destroyer Squadron TWO EIGHT.

2000 NARRATIVE

USS ELROD commenced 2000 at the Naval Station in Norfolk, Virginia while making preparations for a pierside, restricted maintenance availability (PRAV). ELROD was underway in the Virginia Capes during mid-April for sea trials. ELROD got underway in early May from Norfolk enroute to the Halifax operating area to participate in the Canadian exercise CRO 2/00. While operating in the area, ELROD made a port visit to Halifax, Nova Scotia.

The end of May found ELROD returning to sea, enroute to Boston, Massachusetts. While there, ELROD took time to enjoy the Dorchester Day celebrations. Members of her crew and the color guard marched in the Dorchester Day Parade. In early June, ELROD departed from Massachusetts enroute to Newport, RI. At Newport, ELROD was the Surface Warfare Officer School ship, giving tours to newly commissioned Ensigns who were attending SWOS. ELROD also participated in the East Greenwich Navy Day's celebration. ELROD's crew and color guard marched in the parade. ELROD then headed back to Norfolk, VA, for the remainder of the month.

In late June ELROD left Norfolk, VA, this time heading to the New York operating area. In early July she anchored out in New York harbor and subsequently participated in the International Naval Review/Operation Sail 2000. This event took place over the Fourth of July weekend. Once the Operation Sail 2000 was over, ELROD headed back to Norfolk, VA.

Once back in Norfolk, ELROD enjoyed an extended inport period. During the months of July, August, and September ELROD's computers were upgraded with the installation of the new IT-21 system. During this time a new version of CIWS was installed, as well. The Block 1B version of CIWS equipped ELROD with a new, close range offensive surface capability.

During the month of September, several of ELROD's crew spent off duty time to volunteer at Carrallton Elementary School in Suffolk, VA. The volunteers arrived a day before school started to help the teachers arrange desks and prepare for the next day. ELROD's volunteers returned the first day of school to greet the elementary school students. The school volunteers returned in April again to provide tutoring. ELROD's Color Guard accompanied the volunteers on this visit and performed for the students.

In mid-October ELROD was underway again, participating in Joint Tactical Fleet Exercise off the coast of Florida. She made a quick stop in Mayport, FL to refuel before heading to the Virgin Islands' operating area off the coast of St. Thomas. In early November ELROD participated in Prospective Commanding Officer's Operation 00-4. Upon completion of operations, ELROD visited Naval Station Roosevelt Roads Puerto Rico. ELROD next visited St. Thomas. ELROD left St. Thomas and participated in COMDESRON 28 Group Sail, prior to heading back to Norfolk, VA.

A Change of Command ceremony was conducted on 14 December on the Flight Deck while the ship was berthed at Nauticus Maritime Center in Portsmouth, VA. The Ceremony witnessed the transfer of command from Commander Robert W. Bougher, USN to Commander Charles J. Neary, USN. The ELROD was visited by Rear Admiral Malone, Commander Carrier Group Eight, as well as Rear Admiral Cosgriff for the Change of Command ceremony. The remainder of the year was spent pierside at the Naval Station, Norfolk, VA for a holiday leave and upkeep period.

USS ELROD received the following awards during the year 2000: Navy Unit Commendation, NATO Medal Kosovo, NATO Medal Former Yugoslavia, Kosovo Campaign Medal.
