COMMAND COMPOSITION AND ORGANIZATION

MISSION: The mission of the USS ESSEX (LHD 2) is to embark, deploy and land elements of a Marine landing force in an assault by aircraft, landing craft and amphibious vehicles. The USS ESSEX role is the primary flag ship of an amphibious task group. The USS ESSEX is the second ship of the Wasp (LHD 1) class multipurpose amphibious assault ships.

USS ESSEX is specifically designed to operate Landing Craft, Air Cushioned (LCAC) for a waterborne assault, carry Harrier II (AV-8B) Jump Jets for close in air support of the assault force and Helicopters for the deployment of troops and cargo. USS ESSEX operates with a full range of Navy and Marine Corps helicopters, conventional landing craft and amphibious vehicles. The USS ESSEX load out consists of troops, tanks, trucks, armored vehicles, artillery, ammunition and supplies necessary to fully support an amphibious assault.

USS ESSEX is 844 feet long, with a beam of 106 feet. Two steam propulsion plants, capable of developing a combined 70,000 shaft horsepower, to give the 40,500 ton ship the ability to sustain speeds in excess of 20 knots. USS ESSEX has more than 22,000 square feet of vehicle storage space and 100,000 cubic feet of cargo space. Living areas accommodate the 1099 crewmembers and 1961 embarked troops and air crews. For combat support, as well as humanitarian missions, ESSEX has six fully equipped operating rooms, four dental operating rooms and hospital facilities capable of caring for 600 patients. USS ESSEX is home ported in San Diego, California. In a moments notice she could easily become the largest hospital in San Diego county.

USS ESSEX (LHD 2) NARRATIVE 1995

JANUARY

AT THE BEGINNNING OF JANUARY, ESSEX WAS MOORED IN JEBEL ALI. LCAC'S FROM ACU-5 AND THE 13TH MARINE EXPEDITIONARY UNIT CONSISTING OF BATTALION LANDING TEAM 3RD BATTALION/1ST MARINES. MARINE AIRCRAFT SQUADRON 161 AND MEU SERVICE SUPORT GROUP THIRTEEN WERE EMBARKED. THE ARG WAS COMMANDED BY COMMODORE GARY W. STUBBS, COMMANDER, AMPHIBIOUS SQUADRON FIVE. USS OGDEN (LPD-5) AND USS FORT FISHER (LSD-40), BOTH ATTACHED TO THE ARG WERE ALSO MOORED WITH ESSEX. IN JANUARY, ESSEX FINISHED THE HOLIDAY PERIOD AND A TWO WEEK TENDER AVAILABILITY IN JEBEL ALI, U.A.E. AND SAILED FOR AN EXERCISE WITH U.A.E IN THE SOUTHERN ARABIAN GULF. DURING THIS PERIOD, ESSEX AND ACU-5 SAILORS CONDUCTED REPAIRS TO AN LCAC FROM ANOTHER SHIP THAT SUFFERED A CLASS "B" MISHAP IN DECEMBER, TURNING A NON-OPERATIONAL CRAFT INTO A MUCH NEEDED COMBAT READY ASSET. THIS CONCLUDED, SHE SAILED FOR TWO DAYS OF LIBERTY IN DUBAI PRIOR TO DEPARTING THE GULF, HEADED FOR SOMATITA.
