8 January	Shipboard Non-Tactical Automatic Data Processing Program (SNAP II) implementation commenced.
9 January	Training Readiness Evaluation (TRE) commenced in San Diego - GARY was graded "Ready for Training".
ll January	GARY's first Underway Replenishment (with USNS KAWISHIWI). Set sail for Pearl Harbor, HI.
18 January	Arrived Naval Station Pearl Harbor, Hawaii.
21 January	Commenced Refresher Training (Shakedown).
30 January	Conducted ASU-8-B Gunnery Exercise 37 rounds expended with no casualties.
