1. Command Composition and Organization

a. USS GREENEVILLE (SSN 772) is a multi-mission capable, nuclear powered, fast attack submarine. GREENEVILLE is certified to perform anti-submarine warfare, anti-surface warfare, special operations insertion and extraction, TOMAHAWK missile strikes and Mother Submarine (MOSUB) operations. She is the test platform for the Advanced SEAL Delivery System (ASDS), an innovative new special operations vehicle.

b. GREENEVILLE's immediate superior in command is Commander, Submarine Squadron ONE. She is commanded by Commander Robert H. Guy, Jr. and is homeported at Naval Station, Pearl Harbor, HI.

3. Narrative

a. GREENEVILLE began 1998 in Pearl Harbor, HI in a holiday stand-down period. Slated for deployment in July, the Pre-Overseas Movement (POM) cycle began in early January. In addition to at-sea preparations, the ship also underwent POM upkeeps to prepare the ship to deploy to the Western Pacific (WESTPAC).

b. On 22 July, GREENEVILLE left Pearl Harbor for the ship's first Western Pacific Deployment. The deployment was a great success for the ship. The following are some highlights from WESTPAC:

- GREENEVILLE participated in the Republic of South Korea's annual International Fleet Review in Chinhae.
- The ship made the first-ever port call by a nuclear submarine to Malaysia. Port Kelang proved to be an excellent liberty port.

c. The ship ended the year inport Guam for a holiday stand-down.
