2. Command Composition and Organization

a. USS GREENEVILLE (SSN 772) is a multi-mission capable, nuclear powered, fast attack submarine. GREENEVILLE is certified to perform anti-submarine warfare, anti-surface warfare, special operations insertion and extraction, TOMAHAWK missile strikes and Mother Submarine (MOSUB) operations. She is the test platform for the Advanced SEAL Delivery System (ASDS), an innovative new special operations vehicle.

b. GREENEVILLE's immediate superior in command is Commander, Submarine Squadron ONE. She was commanded throughout 2000 by Commander Scott D. Waddle, and is homeported at Naval Station, Pearl Harbor, HI.

4. Narrative

a. GREENEVILLE began 2000 inport Pearl Harbor, HI in a holiday stand-done period. The first portion of the year was devoted to the preparation and conduct of a Tactical Weapons Proficiency, for which the ship received a grade of Above Average.

b. In May, GREENEVILLE conducted an Eastern Pacific deployment. During the conduct of this deployment, the ship conducted operations vital to National Security. Additionally, the ship conducted a highly successful port call to Santa Barbara, CA and conducted two weeks of Midshipman operations near San Diego.

c. From September through December, the ship conducted its first Selected Restricted Availability at the Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard. This availability was highly successful and resulted in a greatly improved material condition.
