## NARRATIVE

USS GUARDIAN began the new year preparing for transit to Miami, FL. After a three day voyage, GUARDIAN arrived in Miami, FL on 22 January for a five day port visit. On 28 January, GUARDIAN departed for NAVSTA Mayport, FL and arrived 24 hours later to commence preparations for degaussing checks scheduled in Charleston, SC.

GUARDIAN departed Mayport, FL on 08 February and arrived Naval Weapons Station Charleston, SC 09 February. Following a brief ammunition onload, berth shift to Naval Station Charleston, SC was conducted for magnetic material offload. From 13-18 February, pierside stray field testing was conducted followed by two days of underway degaussing runs at the Cooper River Magnetic Silencing Facility Degaussing Range. On completon of magnetic material onload, GUARDIAN set sail 24 February for return voyage to Mayport, FL arriving 26 February.

The first week of March emphasized final preparations for the Logistic Management Assessment (LMA). The LMA Team conducted their inspection from 09-12 March assigning an overall command grade of 90 percent and an adjective grade of satisfactory. The remainder of March was utilized for commencement of Operational Propulsion Plant Examination (OPPE) preparations.

On 26 March, GUARDIAN departed Mayport, FL for Ingleside, TX making a short fuel stop in Key West, FL on 28 March. After four days of enroute training, GUARDIAN arrived Ingleside, TX 03 April. From 04 April thru 14 June, final OPPE workups were completed consisting of alternating periods of inport maintenance time and underway idependent ship exercises. The Propulsion Examining Board (PEB) arrived 15 June for commencement of OPPE. On 17 June, the PEB concluded their inspection assigning an overall adjective grade of GOOD. The same day, GUARDIAN departed for final voyage to homeport Mayport, FL arriving 24 June.

On 01 July, USS GUARDIAN officially changed homeport to Ingleside, TX but remained inport Mayport, FL until 17 July for maintenance and degaussing preparations. The ship proceeded to Little Creek, VA on 18 July and conducted magnetic material offload on arrival Little Creek, VA 22 July. The period 23-26 July was spent running the degaussing range at Norfolk Magnetic Silencing Facility. After conducting magnetic material onload on 27 July, the ship departed Little Creek enroute Mayport, FL.

Following a short visit to Mayport, FL (31 July to 02 August), GUARDIAN departed for her new homeport of Ingleside, TX. During the eight day trip, a brief stop for fuel was conducted in Key West, FL. Enroute training emphasis was placed on mine countermeasure systems to kick off preparations for the Mine Readiness Certification Inspection (MRCI). On 11 August, GUARDIAN celebrated her first arrival in her newly designated homeport of Ingleside, TX. After a twelve day homeport change adjustment period, underway training continued for MRCI in Corpus Christi OPAREA.

The period 27 August to 06 September was mostly spent in port for maintenance and change of command preparations. On 27 August, GUARDIAN hosted visit ship for the Chief of Naval Operations, Singapore Navy. The Change of Command Ceremony took place 03 September when LCDR J. S. Jones relieved LCDR W. S. McGee as Commanding Officer. Aggressive MRCI preparations resumed from 07 September until 07 November with alternating training and maintenance periods at sea and in port. On 8 November, the Mine Readiness Certification Inspection Team arrived and conducted the inport phase of the MRCI. The underway phase of MRCI ensued on 9 November and was stretched to the 17 November due to several days of inclement weather. On 17 November the MRCI concluded with a final overall adjective grade of satisfactory assigned.

The balance of November and the month of December were spent inport Ingleside, Tx observing leave and upkeep. On 30 November, LT K. J. Tokarick relieve LCDR T. F. Fessel III as Executive Officer. From 17-26 December, the first of two holiday leave periods were observed with a command muster held 27 December. The second leave period commenced 28 December and continued through 31 December 1993.

For the period 01 January to 31 December 1993, USS GUARDIAN received the following awards: Navy Battle "E" Efficiency Award, Black "E" for Maritime Warfare Excellence, Green "E" for Command and Control Excellence, Red "E" for Engineering/Survivability Excellence, and Blue "E" for Logistics Management Excellence.
