#### COMMAND COMPOSITION AND ORGANIZATION

The USS HENRY M. JACKSON is an OHIO class submarine homeported at Bangor naval submarine base in Bangor, Washington. Trident submarines are undersea intercontinental ballistic missile launching platforms whose primary mission is strategic nuclear deterrence. The submarine is under the operational control of Commander Submarine Squadron 17 and Commander Submarine Group 9 while in port and under the control of Commander Submarine Force Pacific Fleet while deployed at sea.
