June 27	- USS HONOLULU Change of Command, Commander Jonathan William Greenert, U.S. Navy relieved by Commander David Lane Jones, U.S. Navy.



NARRATIVE

The year started with the ship working in preparation for shipyard entry. This time was used to get ready for the Depot Modernization Period at Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard. The major projects for the Depot Modernization Period were the upgrade of various fire-control sensors and systems. In addition, other projects involving modification and refurbishment of ships systems and spaces were begun.

On 27 July HONOLULU held a Change of Command ceremony as CDR Jonathan W. Greenert, USN was relieved by CDR David L. Jones, USN.

Calendar year 1993 ended with HONOLULU in Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard working towards the completion of the Depot Modernization Period.
