

## NARRATIVE

USS HONOLULU spent the first half of 1994 at Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard completing a twenty-two month Depot Modernization Period (DMP).

The last few months of the DMP were spent making final preparations to get the ship ready to go to sea. During this period the ship conducted a comprehensive two phase Crew Certification program which included extensive crew training in both the theoretical and practical aspects of submerged operations at sea. The final phase of the Crew Certification process culminated with a rigorous Fast Cruise agenda which took five days to complete.

The DMP ended with HONOLULU participating in an exceptionally demanding sea trail period. These trials tested all of the ship's systems and equipment, ensuring their ability to operate properly while at sea.

After the completion of Sea Trials, HONOLULU continued training the crew for sea and completed an extremely successful Tactical Weapons Certification (TWC) and Underway Material Inspection (UMI).

The ship finished the year on an Eastern Pacific Deployment (EASTPAC). Port visits included, Nanaimo, BC., CANADA, Esquimalt, BC., CANADA, Alameda, California and San Diego, California. Operations included sound trials in Alaska and a CNO OPEVAL on the ADCAP torpedo.
