#### Narrative.

USS HYMAN G RICKOVER began the year by conducting Sea Trials during the month of January following an Interim Drydocking at Norfolk Naval Shipyard. During the months of February through June, USS HYMAN G RICKOVER conducted various individual exercises and supported various multi submarine exercises. In June, USS HYMAN G RICKOVER commenced pre-overseas movement workup, and conducted various exercises in preparation for the upcoming deployment through the months of July, August and September. USS HYMAN G RICKOVER deployed in October and conducted port visits in Tromso, Norway and Portsmouth, England, ending the year on a North Atlantic Deployment.
