

**COMMAND HISTORY
USS JARRETT (FFG 33)
CALENDAR YEAR 1988**

USS JARRETT returned to Naval Station Long Beach after completing its second Arabian Gulf deployment November 1987. The year 1988 started with hard earned leave for the crew and upkeep pierside from Naval Station support facilities. The first several months were dedicated to local operations and inport upkeep in preparation for several major inspections. The ship successfully completed an Operational Propulsion Plant Re-certification Examination, a Maintenance Material Management (3M) Inspection, INSURV Inspection, Supply Management Assessment and a Command Inspection. Major turnover of personnel including the executive officer, two department heads and approximately twenty-five percent of the crew set the stage for overhaul preparation and future deployment.

Preparation for USS JARRETT's Extended Drydocking Selected Restricted Availability (EDSRA) afforded an opportunity for a highly successful PRE EDSRA Maintenance Availability with SIMA Long Beach June-August 1989. USS JARRETT then headed south for a port visit to Puerto Vallarta, Mexico. Mid September found the JARRETT in San Diego for a training availability followed by a full weapons offload at Concord, CA and a brief liberty stop in San Francisco. Upon return to Long Beach, delays in the beginning of the EDSRA were encountered as a result of problems with the drydock at Southwest Marine, San Pedro, CA. October was an inport upkeep period until the last week when USS JARRETT was assigned as Orange Force Raider for READIEX/KERNAL USHER. With drydock problems resolved, USS JARRETT's EDSRA commenced 16 November 1988. Ship's company moved off the ship to YRBM -39 on 18 November 1988. **Major** installations during EDSRA include:

- AN/SQQ-89 V(2) with SQR-19 tactical towed array Sonar (TACTAS).
- Capabilities (Ship Alt 117), Fin Stabilizers (Ship Alt 001).
- Light Airborne Multi Purpose System (LAMPS) MKIII (Ship Alt 006).
- Recovery Assist, Security and Traversing (RAST) (Ship Alt 004).
- Ship's Service Diesel Generator (SSD6) Rotor replacement. (Ship Alt 103), Halon Upgrade (Ship Alt 067).
- Aqueous Film Forming Form (AFFF) Bilge Sprinkler Upgrade. (Ship Alt 070), and a 4100 ton mod upgrade (Ship Alt 110).

Southwest Marine started repairs and rip-out phase at pierside in the shipyard. Drydocking would not occur until January 1989.
