a. JEFFERSON CITY is an improved Los Angeles class fast attack submarine with a complement of 136 crew members and 14 officers. In addition to traditional submarines roles, JEFFERSON CITY is a vital part of the carrier battlegroup doctrine both as a valuable Tomahawk Cruise Missile launch platform and as a forward deployed intelligence gathering platform.

b. The JEFFERSON CITY is under the immediate command of Commander, Submarine Squadron ELEVEN in San Diego, California.

c. Commander W. M. Smith is assigned as Commanding Officer of the USS JEFFERSON CITY (SSN 759). Enclosure (1) provides his biography.
