

a. Commanding Officer: CDR Joseph G. Henry, USN

b. Immediate senior in command: COMSUBRON EIGHT

- Conduct offensive submarine operations, including offensive anti-submarine warfare, mining operations, and other special submarine operations.

- Conduct submarine anti-submarine warfare in conjunction with other anti-submarine warfare forces and other operations as required.

3. Narrative.

The final new construction phase, Post Shakedown Availability (PSA), was completed on USS KEY WEST (SSN 722) during 1988.
