3. Narrative.

a. USS KEY WEST (SSN 722) participated in the USS CARL VINSON Battle Group COMPTUEX and Integrated Training Assessment, and the USS LINCOLN Battle Group Joint Force Exercise 98-1 during its Eastern Pacific deployment. This was the ship's first underway after deployment and provided many fruitful training opportunities.

b. The ship participated in the multi-national exercise Rim of the Pacific (RIMPAC) `98 in the Hawaiian operating areas. RIMPAC '98 included ships from Japan, Canada, Chile, the Republic of Korea and Austrailia. KEY WEST hosted HMAS Onslow, an Oberon class SS.

c. In the fall, KEY WEST deployed to the Western Pacific and participated in several foreign naval exercises, including FOAL EAGLE '98 with the Republic Of Korea Navy and ANNUALEX with Japan's Joint Maritime Self Defense Force. Port visits to both countries provided the opportunity to engage with Korean and Japanese officers and enlisted men. d. KEY WEST distinguished itself during the deployment as the first submarine to conduct MK48 ADCAP exercise torpedo firings in foreign waters off the coast of the Republic of South Korea in the Sea of Japan. This exercise was considered a great success and proved our weapons and tactics.

e. KEY WEST was awarded the Meritorious Unit Commendation for service in the 1997 Western Pacific Deployment.
