BASIC HISTORY

USS LOS ANGELES (SSN688) began 1984 alongside at Naval Submarine Base, Pearl Harbor, Hawaii preparing for overhaul. On 14 January, the ship entered drydock number one, Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard, Pearl Harbor, Hawaii and commenced her first regular overhaul. The ship received updated sonar, fire control, navigation, and radio systems, and was the first submarine to receive total unit replacement under the LOS ANGELES Class Automatic Equipment Replacement Program (AERP). On 8 March, 1984, Admiral McKee, Director of Naval Reactors visited and toured the ship. On 22 September, 1984, the ship undocked and shifted to Berth B-2, Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard, Pearl Harbor, Hawaii. The remainder of the year was spent completing systems installation and testing.
