NARRATIVE FOR OPERATIONS IN 1991

USS LOS ANGELES commenced 1991 inport Pearl Harbor, HI. The ship conducted local operations in the Hawaiian Opareas and completed preparations for a Western Pacific deployment.

On 15 February, USS LOS ANGELES departed Pearl Harbor, HI, to commence a six month deployment to the Western Pacific. After transiting across the Pacific, USS LOS ANGELES participated in a submarine ASW exercise in the Northwestern Pacific. Following completion of this exercise, USS LOS ANGELES arrived at Yokosuka, Japan, for a brief refit period. Additionally during this port visit, USS LOS ANGELES acted as the USN host ship for the HMAS OVENS, a Royal Australian Navy diesel submarine visiting Yokosuka.

USS LOS ANGELES departed Yokosuka, Japan, on 15 March to participate in other SEVENTH Fleet exercises. Following a personnel transfer in Pohang, ROK, embarked RADM Mathis (COMNAVFORKOREA) and party for an underway demonstration. USS LOS ANGELES arrived in Chinhae, ROK to conduct a deployed upkeep alongside the USS PROTEUS (AS-19).

Following this upkeep, USS LOS ANGELES conducted numerous other exercises with SEVENTH Fleet units. Additionally, USS LOS ANGELES participated in bilateral exercises involving Naval units from several Pacific Rim allied nations. The Western Pacific deployment also included Port Calls in Yokosuka, Japan; Hong Kong; and Subic Bay, RP.

Following completion of the deployment, USS LOS ANGELES conducted a return transit to Pearl Harbor, HI, arriving in home port on 15 August. Following a stand down and refresher training period, USS LOS ANGELES conducted an extensive post deployment repair and pre-overhaul testing period.

In November and December, USS LOS ANGELES conducted several SSN training exercises in the Hawaiian Opareas. USS LOS ANGELES then returned to port to complete preparations for a Northern Pacific Deployment and a holiday stand down period.
