NARRATIVE FOR OPERATIONS IN 1992

USS LOS ANGELES commenced 1992 inport Pearl Harbor, HI. USS LOS ANGELES completed a Submarine Training Between Deployments and an IMA Upkeep Availability period in preparation for a Northern Pacific deployment.

On 9 January, USS LOS ANGELES departed Pearl Harbor, HI, to commence a Northern Pacific Deployment. En route to the deployment operating area, USS LOS ANGELES participated in a submarine ASW exercise.

Following the completion of the Northern Pacific Deployment, USS LOS ANGELES conducted a return transit to Pearl Harbor, HI, arriving in home port on 20 February. Following completion of a stand down and refresher training, USS LOS ANGELES conducted a Pre-overhaul Arrival Testing Schedule and IMA Upkeep through the month of March.

In April and May, USS LOS ANGELES conducted several SSN training exercises in the local Hawaiian Opareas. Additionally during this period, USS LOS ANGELES conducted a Demonstration Cruise for dependants of the ship's crew in the local Hawaiian Opareas.

Following completion of these local operations, USS LOS ANGELES conducted a engineering Pre-Overhaul Testing Schedule and IMA upkeep in June. During this upkeep period USS LOS ANGELES conducted extensive inport training in preparation for the change of homeport and commencement of overhaul.

After conducting RIMPAC-92 work-up exercises with various Allied Navies in the local Hawaiian Opareas, USS LOS ANGELES departed Pearl Harbor, HI and conducted numerous exercises with multi-national forces between 7-22 July in support of RIMPAC-92. Upon completion of RIMPAC-92, USS LOS ANGELES shifted Operational Control to Commander, Submarine Group FIVE.

On 23 July, USS LOS ANGELES arrived in San Diego, CA for a Port Visit and Post RIMPAC-92 Exercise debriefings. Following the port visit, USS LOS ANGELES departed San Diego on 30 July en route Long Beach, CA.

From 31 July through 03 August, USS LOS ANGELES conducted numerous tours and events with visitors from the ship's namesake city while inport Long Beach, CA. On 04 August, USS LOS ANGELES embarked several Distinguished Visitors from the Greater Los Angeles area for a one day demonstration cruise in the Southern California Opareas.

NARRATIVE FOR OPERATIONS IN 1992 (cont)

Following disembarkation of the Distinguished Visitors, USS LOS ANGELES departed Long Beach, CA. Following a transit along the California coast, USS LOS ANGELES arrived in Mare Island, CA, on 06 August.

For the remainder of August, the crew of the USS LOS ANGELES off loaded all stores and spare parts and completed preparations for dry docking. On 01 September USS LOS ANGELES shifted into Dry Dock number 2 at Mare Island Naval Shipyard in preparation for commencing the first Engineered Refueling Overhaul of a "LOS ANGELES" class Nuclear Attack Submarine.

USS LOS ANGELES concluded the year in Dry Dock number 2 at Mare Island Naval Shipyard with numerous ship's systems removed for refurbishment in support of the Engineered Refueling Overhaul.
