1. Command Composition and Organization.

3. Narrative. As of 31 December 1994, there are 29 officers and 254 enlisted personnel onboard. Training is in progress to support readiness for crew certification and sea trials. Ship's company supported all builder testing and key events scheduled for 1994. Operational testing of equipment and turnover of systems from shipyard to ship's force control is on-going.
