USS MIAMI (SSN 755)
COMMAND HISTORY

1. Command Composition and Organization:

USS MIAMI (SSN 755) is currently undergoing Post Shakedown Availability at Electric Boat Division of General Dynamics, Groton, CT. The period of this report is 1 March 1990 to 1 March 1991. Commander Houston K. Jones, USN commands USS MIAMI (SSN 755) homeported at Groton, CT, with Commander Submarine Squadron TWO as his immediate superior in command.

2. Chronology.

- 90APR03-04: ALPHA Sea Trails, VADM DeMars onboard.
- 90JUN30, 1130: MIAMI is commissioned USS MIAMI (SSN 755) with CDR T. W. Mader, USN, Commanding. The first ship duty officer is LT [REDACTED].
- 90JUL05, 1419: Ship is underway for the first time as a commissioned vessel. In transit to the Narragansett Bay Operating Area (NBOA), LT [REDACTED] is the first Officer of the Deck.
- 90JUL05, 2219: Submerged the ship for the first time as a commissioned vessel. LCDR [REDACTED] is the first submerged Officer of the Deck. Arrived at the NBOA'S.
- 90JUL06: Departed NBOA's. Conducted various operations while enroute to first port visit.
- 90JUL17: Arrived at Roosevelt Roads, PR, ship's first port visit.
- 90JUL25: Departed Roosevelt Roads.
- 90JUL25-90AUG14: Conducted various operations while enroute to homeport of Groton, CT.
- 90AUG15: Arrived in Groton, CT. Our first extended underway complete. Underway for a total of 45 days as a commissioned vessel. Total miles steamed 7,958.5 Nautical Miles (NM).
- 90AUG18: Underway for our first dependents cruise, in Long Island Sound. Total miles steamed 74.0 NM.

90AUG18- USS MIAMI (SSN 755) in its first upkeep at
90SEP27 its homeport, Groton, CT.

90SEP07: CDR T. W. Mader, USN is relieved by CDR H. K.
JONES, USN, as Commanding Officer.

90SEP28: Departed Groton, CT, for underway operations.

90SEP29- Conducted underway operations while enroute
90OCT16 to Port Everglades, FL.

90OCT17: Arrived at Port Everglades, FL for ship's
first official visit to Miami, FL.

90OCT17-20: At Port Everglades, FL.

90OCT20: Underway for a VIP cruise, than transit to
Port Everglades Operating Area (PEOA).

90OCT31- VADM Roger F. Bacon (COMSUBLANT) embarked
90NOV01 and, rode from Port Canaveral to Port
Everglades.

90NOV01- Conducted underway operations, while
90NOV11 transitting to Groton, CT.

90NOV07-12: Transit to NBOA's.

90NOV13- First Operational Reactor Safeguards
90NOV14 Examination (ORSE) conducted on ship.

90NOV14-28: In port at Groton, CT for upkeep and
maintenance. Phrase "Beat Army" painted on
sail for video taping and possible airing
during Army/Navy football game.

90NOV28: Departed Groton, CT, transit to NBOA's.
Ship videotaped and photographed for "Beat
Army" sign.

90NOV28- Conducted underway operations.
90DEC13

90DEC03- First Tactical Weapons Certification
90DEC06 conducted on ship.

90DEC13, 2257: Surfaced the ship for last time for the
year. Departed NBOA's, transit to
Groton, CT.

90DEC14, 1020: Ship is moored at Groton, CT. Last underway for the year completed. Total miles steamed since commissioning: 23,517.05 NM.
