Mission / Command Employment / Operations: MONTEREY's primary mission is to provide Ballistic missile defense. MONTEREY's secondary mission is to provide air defense to a High Value Unit such as a Aircraft Carrier. MONTEREY can also coordinate and execute operations in Anti-Submarine Warfare, Anti-Surface Warfare, Maritime Interdiction, Strike Warfare, and a variety of other warfare areas. MONTEREY has the capability to embark two SH-60 Seahawk helicopters. The crew trains underway primarily off the coast of Virginia, but training operations have taken her up and down the East Coast, to the Caribbean, and North Atlantic. When deployed, MONTEREY typically operates in COMSIXTHFLT, COMFIFTHFLT, or SOUTHCOM Area of Responsibility. MONTEREY began the year at sea participating in Integrated Level Training with the USS HARRY S. TRUMAN Carrier Strike Group. Following this, MONTEREY successfully passed a material inspection by the Board of Inspection and Survey and then deployed to the FIFTH and SIXTH Fleet Area of Responsibilities.
