USS OGDEN was one of several Amphibious Squadron Seven ships involved in the Exercise Kernel Usher 85-1. Other units participating were the 11th MAU and a carrier group led by USS CONSTELLATION.

The exercise, involving more than 10,000 Maines and sailors and 20 ships, involved the embarkation of Marines, at-sea operations with the carrier battle group and amphibious assault operations ashore.

This Third Fleet exercise set the precedent for being the first such operation in recent history to load out the amphibious units and begin the training evolution from the homeport of the participating amphibious squadron. Also, the embarked troops from the 11th MAU will be the same personnel who will be deploying with OGDEN and other units of Amphibious Squadron SEVEN to the Pacific in 1985.

During Kernel Usher 85-1, USS OGDEN was the Primary Control Ship for all amphibious landings and withdrawals. It was OGDEN's responsibility to coordinate all boat and amphibious vehicle movement ashore. These precise evolutions were conducted both day and night, often during inclement weather.

OGDEN air operations included aviation ordnance handling in support of Marine AHLJ Cobra gunships, the first time this has ever been done onboard a U.S. Navy LPD class ship.

The arming of the helos was undertaken by temporarily assigned aviation ordnancemen from the USS PELELIU and gunner's mates from the OGDEN. The successful completion of the aviation ordnance evolutions demonstrated the flexibility of LPD class ships in supporting amphibious air operations.

OGDEN also logged 128 safe helo landings and take-offs in support of the landing forces on the beach. The flight operations included troop movements to the beach and resupply.
