Part 3. Narrative

A. Written Summary: 1996 began with comprehensive training in preparation for an extended training deployment to the North Atlantic. This training included significant classroom hours as well as at-sea workups. Pre-Overseas Movement (POM) workup and certification concluded in the middle of March, and USS PHILADELPHIA was prepared to get underway for the Northern Atlantic. The primary purpose of this training deployment was to demonstrate the ability to operate unsupported by outside organizations for an extended period of time. Included in this mission were 73 consecutive days of submerged operations. As the deployment came to a conclusion, extensive training was conducted in preparation for USS PHILADELPHIA'a second Operational Readiness Safeguards Examination (ORSE) since refueling overhaul was completed in 1994. USS PHILADELPHIA received superior grades during this intense inspection. After returning to homeport in Groton, CT., USS PHILADELPHIA began preparations for it's Tactical Readiness Examination (TRE) and it's Logistics Readiness Evaluation (LRE). The ship performed superbly on the TRE and was graded as excellent overall and recognized as a TRE "Top Performer" for 1996. USS PHILADELPHIA completed it's inspection cycle in October when the ship was evaluated as above average on it's LRE. In addition, the ship was nominated as the Atlantic Fleet finalist for the 1997 CAPT Edward F. NEY award in exceptional food service. USS PHILADELPHIA concluded calendar year 1996 by being selected as the Battle Efficiency "E" recipient for Submarine Development Squadron 12.
