THE YEAR IN REVIEW

The year began with USS SHREVEPORT (LPD 12) deployed for the third time in less than 24 months. After spending Christmas in Palma De Mallorca, Spain, SHREVEPORT set sail for Toulon, France to participate in Exercise "Mayflower". The first quarter of 1992 came to a close following port visits to Haifa, Israel; Rota Spain; Lisbon, Portugal; and Marseille, France.

The second quarter began with a Restricted Availability (RAV) with USS PUGET SOUND in Izmir, Turkey. The end of the quarter saw USS SHREVEPORT participate in exercise "Dragon Hammer". Dragon Hammer was the major exercise of the deployment, and featured naval operations with ships from England, Greece, Israel and France.

On 04 June 1992, USS SHREVEPORT pulled into Moorhead City, NC to offload Marines, amphibious assault equipment and embark Tigers for the much anticipated transit home. On 05 June 1992, the USS SHREVEPORT returned to Norfolk.

After her return to Norfolk, SHREVEPORT's crew enjoyed a one month standdown followed by underway midshipman training. SHREVEPORT then offloaded her ammunition and completed a Dependent's Cruise before entering Metro Machine, Inc. for a much needed DPMA level of repair work.

On 16 December, Captain A. G. Harms, Jr. relieved Captain R. L. Peterson as the Commanding Officer, USS SHREVEPORT (LPD 12). Captain Harms is the 15th Commanding Officer of USS SHREVEPORT (LPD 12).
