- 1. Per reference (a), the calendar year 1995 Command History for USS TARAWA (LHA 1) is submitted.
- 2. Command Composition and Organization:
- a. Mission and Function of the Command: The Amphibious Task Force, which executes its tasks in support of the Navy's force projection mission, is composed of LHA, LHD, LPD, LPH and LSD class ships. TARAWA, the lead ship of the LHA class of general purpose amphibious assault ships, combines the functional capabilities of the LPD, LSD, LPH, and the LST to deliver a balanced payload, by air or surface operations, in an amphibious assault. Explicitly, a former Chief of Naval Operations defined the LHA's mission as follows: "To embark, deploy and land elements of a Marine Landing Force in an assault by helicopter, landing craft, amphibious vehicles and by any combination of these methods."

4. Narrative:

January 1995 found TARAWA pierside at Naval Station San Diego completing a holiday leave and upkeep period. Between January 17-26, TARAWA successfully completed Combat Systems Ship's Qualification Testing in the SOCAL OPAREA. TARAWA was next underway from March 21-22, completing sea trials in the SOCAL OPAREA and returning to mooring at Naval Station San Diego.

Most of April 1995 was spent underway for Tailored Ship Training Availability Phase One (or TSTA I). TSTA I was successfully performed from April 3-7, 10-14, and 17-21.

TARAWA was next underway during its April 24-28 period for Type Training in the SOCAL OPAREA, anchoring for two days off Camp Pendleton to onload ammunition by helicopter. Afterwards, TARAWA remained inport until May 15, when the ship commenced TSTA II in three underway periods from May 15-19, 22-26, and May 30 to June 2 in the SOCAL OPAREA. TARAWA did so well on TSTA II that it was permitted to skip TSTA III. TARAWA underwent the first part of TSTA IV from June 26-29.

The inport period from June 29 to July 4 was spent in preparation for the ship's transit to Pearl Harbor for a five-week MIDPAC cruise.

July 5 witnessed TARAWA departing for its first prolonged underway period since its Complex Overhaul. Before departing, TARAWA onloaded 1,300 short tons of various equipment and material, including 140 automobiles and a number of speed boats, in support of "Opportune Lift," a program where service members and retirees can get free shipment of goods from Navy ships en route to their port, saving time and taxpayer money.

TARAWA moored at Pearl Harbor on July 11. From July 13-19, TARAWA embarked Special Operations Command, Pacific, for the joint exercise Tarpaulin Minnow (conducted in the MIDPAC OPAREA) before returning pierside to Pearl Harbor. From July 26-31, TARAWA again operated in the MIDPAC OPAREA, this time to complete COMPTUEX-95-13M, better known as exercise Blue Marlin. After a few days of liberty, TARAWA left on August 2 for homeport, Naval Station San Diego, arriving pierside on August 10.

TARAWA's next challenge was the Operational Propulsion Plant Examination (OPPE), which was completed in late September. TARAWA spent its September 6-9 and 18-22 periods underway conducting OPPE preps. TARAWA was again underway from September 27-29, passing OPPE on the first try.

On October 2, TARAWA completed TSTA IV, and from October 10-13, TARAWA accomplished TSTA III (part one), both underway in the SOCAL OPAREA.

The ship sailed on October 14 for a Family Day Cruise in the SOCAL OPAREA. Approximately 1,800 family and friends participated, enjoying displays of ship's systems, tours, an LCAC demonstration, and a "Steel Beach Picnic" held on the flight deck.

TSTA III was successfully completed in the SOCAL OPAREA from October 16-20, and the Final Evaluation Period was successfully completed during the October 24-26 period in the SOCAL OPAREA.

TARAWA remained inport from October 26 until December 7 when the ship got underway for COMPTUEX-96-3M. Having already embarked the 13th Marine Expeditionary Unit, TARAWA then operated in concert with the other ships of the TARAWA Amphibious Readiness Group (DULUTH and RUSHMORE), successfully completing the first of its pre-deployment workups.

TARAWA moored at Naval Station, San Diego on December 15 and began its holiday stand-down, which lasted until January 8, 1996.
