- a. Commanding Officer: Captain J. E. MAGEE, USN, //1120 from 19 June 1970 to 15 September 1972.
- b. Commanding Officer: Captain R. B. DAVEY, USN, from 15 September 1972 to present.
- c. Executive Officer: Commander E. E. STEINBRINK, USN, Olllo from 31 July 1971 to present.
 - d. Homeport: Long Beach, California.
- e. Mission and Function: As a unit of the Mobile Logistic Support Force, to furnish repair force, repair force, repair facilities, and limited support to various types of ships of the fleet, and function as a Flagship for Service Group Commanders.

2. Summary of Operation

The year began with HECTOR inport at Long Beach, California providing Fleet Repair Services (FRS) to the fleet and preparation for overseas movement. On 3 January 1972 HECTOR departed from her homeport for an extended deployment as a unit under the operational control of Commander Service Group THREE providing fleet repair services to units of Commander Seventh Fleet and the Republic of Vietnam.

On 3 January 1972, HECTOR commenced her voyage to WESTPAC towing a Korean PG, PAEK-KU (PGM-11) (EX-BENECIA PG-96) to Sasebo, Japan via Pearl Harbor, Hawaii. On 12 January 1972, HECTOR moored to M-3 berth, Naval Station, Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, for an overnight stay. On 13 January 1972, HECTOR was underway for Sasebo, Japan leaving behind the Korean PG for repair on damages encountered while enroute.

On 26 January 1972, HECTOR moored at Berth 9, India Basin, Fleet Activities Sasebo, Japan.

On 27 January 1972, USS JASON (AR-8) completed turn-over of Commander Service Group THREE Staff to USS HECTOR (AR-7) and HECTOR assumed Flagship function and Fleet Repair Service until 17 February 1972.

On 17 February 1972, HECTOR underway for Vung Tau, RVN to provide repair services to units of the Vietnamese Navy.

On 23 February 1972, HECTOR anchored at B-17 Vung Tau, RVN and immediately provided repair services to units of Vietnamese Navy. On 14 March 1972, HECTOR completed repair services, underway for Hong Kong for rest and recreation.

On 17 March 1972, HECTOR arrived Hong Kong and moored to Buoy No. 2.

On 23 March 1972, HECTOR underway for Sasebo, Japan and arrived Sasebo on 26 March 1972. On 26 March 1972, inport Sasebo, Japan, and commenced Fleet Repair Services to units of Seventh Fleet until 11 April 1972.

On 11 April 1972, HECTOR was directed to proceed immediately to Danang, RVN to provide emergency battle damage repair services to units of Seventh Fleet engaging in Gun Fire Support operations off the coast of Vietnam.

On 15 April 1972, HECTOR moored at anchoraged in Danang, RVN harbor and immediately provided emergency battle damage repair services to units of Seventh Fleet. At sunset every day HECTOR was underway for night steaming operations until first light the following morning before entering Danang harbor to continue emergency repair services.
