


GULFSTREAM SRA-4 PRIORITY CARGO



The large cargo door installed on the right side of the Gulfstream SRA-4, together with an efficient roller handling system, allows easy loading of bulky items.

The requirement for rapid movement of specialized cargo, such as high-value commodities or parts, or time-sensitive supplies and parcels, can be met easily with the Gulfstream SRA-4.

The flat floor and stand-up headroom for the entire length of the cabin permit efficient loading; when equipped with a roller system, the aircraft will accommodate large palletized containers.

The floor construction offers uniform strength throughout, with floor loading capacity of 100 pounds per square foot (489 kg/m²).

The maximum payload available in a cargo configuration of the Gulfstream SRA-4 is 9,200 pounds (4173 kg).
