Naval Station Norfolk Tours

The 45-minute bus tour departs from the Naval Tour and Information Office located at 9079 Hampton Boulevard next to Gate 5. The bus drives past aircraft carriers, destroyers, submarines, frigates, and amphibious assault ships. Visitors will also view the historic homes from the 1907 Jamestown Exposition. Cameras are allowed. Tour schedules are subject to change, so it is suggested that you call the tour office at 757-444-7955 for departure times.


